

2018 Manitoba Winter Games Fill Policy

Rationale

A Fill Policy will allow Regions, which have a full complement of competitors at the conclusion of the Regional Team selection, to add members to a region which is not able to field a full team.

1. This Fill Policy will provide an avenue for A.B.A.M to maximize opportunity for a maximum number of developing athletes.
2. To ensure regions that have large participation numbers in Archery to provide opportunities for additional athletes to participate at the Games.

Criteria

1. The number of athletes competing will not exceed the maximum number of projected athletes from all regions.
2. The additional athletes must be fully eligible as per the Sport Technical Package.
3. Coaches, managers and all team support staff are excluded from the Fill Policy.

Selection Process Priority

PRIORTIY 1:

First priority selection of athletes will be given to the athletes that place in the top two (2) in their respective gender category and equipment division at their regional qualifier.

PRIORTIY 2:

Second priority selection will be given to athletes that placed outside of the top two (2) spots in their regional qualifier to be reallocated to an alternate region that is unable to fill two (2) athletes in that specific gender category and equipment division. In the case there are more athletes than unfilled spots, total score from all regional qualifiers will be used to prioritize athletes.

Example: West Region & East Region both have one unfilled spot in Male Compound. Winnipeg Blue Region & South Region have a combined 5 athletes that did not qualify in their region, the athletes will be combined and ranked by total score from their respective qualifier. The top 2 athletes will be reallocated to the West & East Region Teams as determined by the technical delegate.

PRIORTIY 3:

Third priority selection will be given to athletes that placed outside of the top two (2) spots in their regional qualifier to be reallocated to an alternate region that is unable to fill two (2) athletes in either equipment division. In the case there are more athletes than unfilled spots, total score from all regional qualifiers will be used to prioritize athletes.

Example: West Region & East Region both have one unfilled spot in Female Recurve. Winnipeg Blue Region & South Region have a combined 5 athletes that did not qualify in their region in the Female Compound category. Given priority two has been exercised and athletes are willing to switch equipment categories, the athletes will be combined and ranked by total score from their respective qualifier. The top two (2) athletes will be reallocated to the West & East Region Teams as determined by the technical delegate.

PRIORTIY 4:

Fourth priority selection will be given to athletes that did not participate in a regional qualifier. This priority is to be utilized in the event that priorities one – three have been exercised and regional team spots remain. Selection and regional allocation of the athlete will be determined by the technical delegate by the acknowledgment of an extenuating circumstance such as injury and by utilizing the following subjective criteria:

a) Past Performance

- The athlete's prior experience and results at the local level will be taken into consideration.

b) Future Potential

- Consideration may be given to an athlete's future potential with respect to talent, commitment and performance.
- Depending on the event, athletes may be selected who, in the opinion of the selectors, have the potential to represent a region at the Manitoba Games and would benefit from exposure to this level of competition.
