



ABAM Bingo Funding Grant Program

The ABAM Bingo Funding Grant has been established to reflect the recent changes to the Manitoba Liquor & Lotteries Provincial Bingo Funding Program. As our organization is no longer required to fill bingo volunteer positions in order to meeting funding requirements, a grant process has been established to prioritize funding to clubs that are in need of support to host activities and grow the sport with in their community.

The ABAM Bingo Funding Grant Program is available to all affiliated ABAM clubs in good standing. Application approval and funding levels will be at the discretion of the ABAM Executive Committee. The application and review process will be monthly throughout the 2017 – 2018 fiscal year (April 1, 2017 – March 31, 2018). Clubs will be required to send their application, along with any required documents to the ABAM Office for the review by the Executive Committee. The monthly deadline for application submission is five (5) days in advance of the next Executive Committee meeting. Clubs will be informed of funding approval within five (5) business days of the most recent Executive Committee meeting.

Clubs are eligible to submit for funding up to \$1000 per fiscal year (April 1 – March 31). If approved for funding, fifty percent (50%) of the funding will be allocated immediately. The remaining fifty percent (50%) will be paid out at the end of the fiscal year (March 2018) after the applicant has submitted a copy of their yearend operating budget.

Funding Categories

Event(s) Host Subsidy:

Host Target Clubs can submit for funding support in the following areas:

- Tournament Affiliation Fees (Archery Canada & World Archery)
- Officials – Judge Mileage & Honorarium
- Facility Fees

Development Programming:

All Clubs are eligible to submit for Learn to Shoot Programming Costs that include:

- Facility Fees
- Coach Mileage
- ABAM Archery in Schools Program Support

Special Initiatives:

All Clubs are eligible to submit for special initiatives such as:

- Coach Training Support
- Officials Training Support
- Coach or Officials training clinic host support
- Fundraiser or Promotional Event
- Facility creation or enhancement project
- Archery Related Equipment purchase
